- What to bring\*\*
  - Simple items to serve with or without church's cookies (60 people)
  - Nothing but the church's cookies

\*\*The church does not stock disposable flatware, cups or glasses. Plan to bring your own if you care to. **No Styrofoam Please!** We want to stay as green as possible while minimizing dishwashing chores. With this in mind, you are encouraged to use our chinaware when time allows. Also please remove all unused disposable items at the end of the day.

- What you'll find for food presentation:
  - Compostable or ceramic plates
  - Carafes, coffee pots, serving pieces. These require washing.
  - Cloth or paper napkins, tablecloths
  - A dinner bell for summoning kitchen help after 12:15
- What food supplies you'll find in the kitchen:
  - Pre-measured coffee in baggies and properly fitting coffee filters
  - Tea, sugar, sweetener, dry creamer
  - Half & Half and juice
  - Cookies \*\*\*

\*\*\*There is a bin of Allergen-Free snacks in the pantry. **THESE ARE SELF-SERVE ITEMS AND ARE NOT TO BE PUT OUT ON THE BUFFET.** Parents and children managing allergies know the drill and should be allowed to help themselves.

- What volunteer hosts do on Sunday AM
  - Set tablecloths, serving items and snacks out in Olympia Brown Room
  - Brew coffee and hot water for tea. Set these out in OBR
  - Hover during social hour to refill coffee carafes or help with snacks
  - Condense snack items as they thin out
  - Remove all items from OBR beginning 12:15. Wash and sanitize serving items/plates/cups, wipe tables, put cloths in laundry basket and move trash to kitchen bins. Generally, leave kitchen spiffy.
